



and their deviations including sign change with respect to the Penalty imposed on the State and whether the same has been submitted for the period under dispute in a consolidated form which can be compared?

10. Shri Rahul Srivastava could not reply the specific query of the Commission but tried to argue by submitting that the Commission has imposed the fine of ₹ 50,000/- upon Indian Railways in Petition no. 1377 of 2018 on the ground on noncompliance of the Grid Code by the petitioner by overdrawing the electricity at its various TSS points. The Commission expressed its displeasure over non reply of the query and non-submission of the desired information and advised Sh. Rahul Srivastava, Counsel of UPSLDC, to come prepared for the hearing. Furthermore, the Commission is constrained to observe that SLDC has wasted its time and warned it that in future such behavior shall invite a penalty/ strict action.
11. Considering above, the Commission once again directs SLDC to submit the day wise consolidated details of penalty imposed on account of DSM, Additional DSM and sign change on each Discom viz-a -viz same imposed on State of Uttar Pradesh by NLDC from 01.01.2019 to 30.06.2019 as per the format annexed to this order within three (03) weeks.
12. The matter is next listed for hearing on 20th July, 2021.
