## ORDER

Subject: Nomination of third party Bid Process Coordinator for the Revised scheme for flexibility in Generation and Scheduling of Thermal/ Hydro Power Stations through bundling with Renewable Energy and Storage Power, 2022.

Reference is invited to this Ministry's letter No. 09/11/2021-RCM dated 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 on the Revised Scheme for flexibility in Generation and Scheduling of Thermal/ Hydro Power Stations through bundling with Renewable Energy and Storage Power, 2022.

- 2. The clause 3.3 of the revised scheme is reproduced below -
- "A Generating Company under section 62 or its subsidiary shall also be allowed to establish an RE power plant through tariff based competitive bidding process under section 63 provided the bids are called by a Central Government approved third party."
- 3. In fulfillment of the requirements of aforementioned clause, the following companies/agencies shall be the third party Bid Process Coordinators for the said scheme:
  - a. NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Ltd.
  - b. PFC Consulting Ltd.
  - c. REC Power Development and Consultancy Ltd.
- 4. Furthermore, where a Joint Venture or a holding company or a subsidiary invites bids, the BPC shall be an entity independent of the holding company or its subsidiaries.
- 5. This issues with the approval of Hon'ble Minister of Power and New & Renewable Energy.
