Subject: Draft Resource Adequacy Guidelines-Stakeholder Comments

Resource adequacy is the ability of an electric power system to serve load across a broad range of system operating conditions. The adequacy plan also helps Discoms to plan their resource requirement optimally leveraging the benefits of the diversity of power requirements among the states thereby reducing the cost of power procurement.

In this regard, CEA has prepared draft Guidelines for Resource Adequacy which can be adopted by the Discoms to plan for resource adequacy.

A National workshop on “Resource Adequacy- Need and way forward” was also organized by Central Electricity Authority on 22nd September, 2022 in New Delhi to present the need of RA in Indian context and to discuss the key features of the draft RA guidelines.
