The applicant should have designed, supplied, installed and successfully commissioned at least 1 MW Rooftop solar power plant in a single plant location in the last 5 years period and the plant must be in successful operation. - Reference installations and completion certificate for the Rooftop solar system, installed in last 5 years.
