**Record of Proceedings**

At the outset, the learned counsel for Petitioner sought adjournment of the hearing on the ground that since Unit-I of the generating station had achieved COD on 28.9.2023 and that Unit-II is expected to achieve COD in December 2023, the Petitioner may be permitted to file an amended petition, in the matter. The learned counsel for the Respondent TS Discoms sought time to file their reply to the amended petition to be filed by the Petitioner.

2. The Commission, after hearing the learned counsel for the Petitioner, permitted the Petitioner to file an amended Petition in respect of Unit-I, after serving copies on the Respondents, on or before **4.1.2024**. The Respondents may file their replies on or before **20.1.2024**, after serving a copy on the Petitioner, who may, file its rejoinder, if any, by **2.2.2024**. The parties shall complete pleadings within the due dates mentioned, and no extension of time shall be granted.

3. The Petition shall be listed for hearing on **9.2. 2024**.
