# ORDER (DATE OF HEARING: 04.04.2024)

- 1. The Commission vide order dated 13.3.2024 adjourned the hearing and allowed UPPCL to file its submission within 2 weeks, as requested.
- 2. During hearing today, UPPCL Counsel submitted that CERC vide its order dated 14.3.2023 has adopted tariff, however, the SPPA is yet to be signed with SECI. It was also informed that UPPCL has already consented SECI on the revised PSA. SECI's Counsel affirmed the same. The counsel sought 3 weeks' time for submission of revised PSA and the information sought by Commission vide its earlier orders.
- 3. The Commission after hearing parties allowed request of UPPCL & SECI.
