Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition has been filed for the adoption of the tariff of 100 MW Wind Power Projects connected with the Inter-State Transmission System and selected through the competitive bidding process as per the “*Guidelines for Tariff Based Competitive Bidding Process for Procurement of Power from Grid connected RE Power Projects for utilisation under the Scheme for Flexibility in Generation and Scheduling of Thermal/Hydro Power Stations through Bundling with Renewable Energy and Storage Power*” notified by the Ministry of Power, Govt. of India vide Notification dated 27.8.2022. Learned counsel submitted that pursuant to the bid process, the Petitioner has issued the Letter of Awards to the successful bidders viz. Respondent No.1, Juniper Green Energy Private Limited, for 50 MW @ Rs. 3.58/kWh, and Respondent No.2, Avaada Energy Private Limited, for 50 MW @ Rs. 3.59/kWh. Learned counsel added that the Petitioner has also impleaded all of its beneficiaries as Respondents.

2. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission ordered as under:



- (a) Admit and issue notice to Respondents.
- (b) Respondents to file their respective replies within two weeks with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within two weeks thereafter.
