Representative of the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition had been filed for adoption of transmission charges with respect to "Transmission System for evacuation of Power from Rajasthan REZ Ph-IV (Part 2: 5.5 GW) (Jaisalmer/ Barmer Complex) Part C" as discovered pursuant to the tariff based competitive bidding process as per the Guidelines issued by the Central Government. The representative also added that there has been a delay of 9 days in filing the present application for a grant of a transmission licence, which may also be condoned.

- 2. Considering the submissions made by the representative of the Petitioner, the Commission ordered as under:
 - (a) Admit and issue notice to Respondents subject to just exceptions.
