1. The Bid forms containing the Terms and Conditions, the tender and the Schedule of contract, should be submitted online failing which the tender shall be liable for rejection. In the event of the space on the Schedule of contract / specifications of items/proforma being insufficient for the required purpose, additional pages may be added. Each such additional page must be numbered consecutively, bearing the Tender Number and be duly signed and stamped by the bidder. In such cases, reference to the additional pages must be made in the Tender Form. If any modification of the schedule is considered necessary, you should communicate the same by means of separate letter sent along with the Tender.

2. PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF TENDERS / BIDS:

PART -1 TECHNICAL BID:

Technical Bid along with tender documents (duly signed on each page) to be uploaded in the e-procurement portal. Technical Bid to be opened by the REIL committee. Board resolution/ Authorization letter for signing of the bid document from the bidder be submitted. Prices / Costs of the items should not be indicated anywhere in the Technical Bid. This should be followed meticulously failing which the bid is liable to be rejected.

All eligibility documents should be submitted with the technical bid.

PART -2 FINANCIAL BID:

Price Bid BOQ given with tender is to be uploaded strictly as per the format available with the tender failing which the offer is liable for rejection (renaming or changing format of BOQ sheet will not be accepted by the system).

1. **OPENING OF TENDER:**

The **Price/Financial bids** of the bidders whose technical bids are found technically suitable only will be opened later. **The decision of the evaluation committee on technical suitability shall be final and binding.**

2. PRICES:

- i. Prices/Financial bid are to be BOQ in Indian Rupees and must be meaningful and measurable in the context.
- ii. Bidders should clearly specify whether prices quoted are inclusive of GST/duties/ statutory charges or such charges as extra. Where no specific mention GST or other duties quoted shall be **deemed to be inclusive of such taxes** / charges.
- iii. Price must be quoted in original sheet of BOQ failing which the same is liable to be rejected.
- iv. Evaluation will be done on total price quote by bidders.
- v. REIL has reserve to right for negotiation with L1 bidder.

3. OFFER VALIDITY:

Validity of offer shall be 90 days from tender opening date.

4. EMD:

Interested bidder shall submit Earnest Money (EMD) equal to 2% of estimated tender cost. The EMD amount shall be deposited in forum of Demand Draft/RTGS/Bank Guarantee to REIL .the EMD should be valid for a period of 45 days beyond the bid validity period (i.e 135 days from last date of submission of bid). The bid shall be treated as non responsive in case of non submission of EMD amount. No interest shall paid towards EMD amount.

EMD shall be forfeited without prejudice to the bidder being liable for any further consequential loss or damage incurred to JAKEDA under following circumstances:-

100% of EMD amount, if a Bidder withdraws/revokes or cancels or unilaterally varies his bid in any manner.

5. WORK ALLOCATION :-

After opening of financial bid, the lowest quoted price shall be declared as L1 bidder. L1 bidder may invite for further negotiation. The work may be distributed between L1 and L2 bidders on L1 rate in 70:30 ratio after acceptance of L1 rate by L2 party. 100% work may awarded to L1 bidder in case of non acceptance by L2 bidder. REIL reserves the right to allocate specific site capacity distribution.

6. SECURITY DEPOSIT

Security Deposit amounting to 5% of the total contract value is to be submitted within 7 days from the date of issue of LOI/Work order by successful bidder. Security deposit shall be refunded on completion of Supply , Installation – Commissioning and handover the Solar Street Lighting systems to concern authority within completion period mentioned in tender. Security deposit may submit in fourm of Bank Guarantee/RTGS/Demand Draft. Bank Guarantee shall be issued by nationalize bank approved from RBI only. Security deposit may also be considered for PBG after completion of project within stipulated time as per NIT. Balance amount shall be released to

successful bidder after completion of project. REIL reserves the right to forfeit the security deposit in case bidder fails to complete the project within stipulated completion period.

If bidder fails to execute the work, the bidder may be blacklisted and debarred by REIL.

7. PERFORMANCE BANK GURANTTEE:-

Successful bidder shall submit PBG equal to 5% of total Contract Value within 15 days after installation –Commissioning of System in the form of BG/RTGS valid upto 66 months from date of commissioning. Bank Guarantee shall be issued by nationalize bank approved from RBI only.

8. PROJECT INSPECTION

The project shall be monitored by REIL/Authorized Agency and the projects shall be inspected for quality at any time during commissioning or after the completion of the project either by officer(s) from REIL/Authorized Agency. REIL/Authorized Agency may also nominate a technical person(s)/agency(ies) /body(s) for inspection, third party verification, monitoring of system installed to oversee the implementation as per required standards and also to visit the manufactures facilities to check the quality of products as well as to visit the system integrators to assess their technical capabilities as and when required. The cost of Inspection shall be borne by the Bidder only.

9. Pre-dispatch Inspection

The material shall be dispatched only after Pre-dispatch inspection by Third Party Inspection /Monitoring Agency (TPIA) through designated agencies accredited by Quality Council of India (QCI)/NABL/MNRE Approved labs.

The bidder may choose to furnish multiple inspection reports for small lots as per the work orders or a single inspection report for the full allotted quantity as per the BOQ. **Material Inspection by** REIL/Authorized Agency Shall be conducted when key project components including solar panels, Pole, Battery and Luminaries are delivered at site.

10. Test Report

Successful bidder shall submit test report in the Name of REIL for the complete SSL system (including SPV Module of REIL make) from NABL accredited/BIS approved test centers within 15 days from date of award of work and prior to supply of system.

PROJECT COST

The Project cost shall include all the costs related to above Scope of work. Bidder shall quote for the entire facilities on a "single responsibility" basis such that the total Bid Price shall cover the obligations mentioned in the Bidding Documents in respect of Supply of BoS, Storage, Packaging, Transportation (Except SPV Modules), Installation & Commissioning and 5 years CMC of Solar Street Lighting Systems at various districts/shrines in J&K. The Bidder has to take all permits, approvals and licenses, insurance etc., provide training and such other items and services required to complete the scope of work mentioned above.

The price quoted is on lump sum turnkey basis including all taxes & duties applicable and the bidder is responsible for the total scope of work described as above.

The project cost shall remain firm and fixed and shall be binding on the Successful Bidder till completion of work. No escalation will be granted on any reason what so ever. The bidder shall not be entitled to claim any additional charges, even though it may be necessary to extend the completion period for any reasons what so ever.

The cost shall be inclusive of all duties and taxes, insurance etc. The prices quoted by the firm shall be complete in all respect and no price variation/adjustment shall be payable.

The Project cost shall be specified by the successful Bidder" quote @ Rs per system for each project. The project cost shall be in accordance with all terms, conditions, specifications and other conditions of the Contract as accepted by the REIL and incorporated into the Rate Contract order.

The Vendor shall be responsible and take an Insurance Policy for transit- cum- storage-cumerection for all the materials to cover all risks and liabilities for supply of materials on site basis, storage of materials at site, erection, testing and commissioning.

The Vendor shall also take insurance for Third Party Liability covering loss of human life, engineers and work men and also covering the risks of damage to the third party / material/ equipment/ properties during execution of the Contract. A. Installation &Commissioning:

Bidder has to obtain handing over certificates/ installation completion letters/ certificates from respective State agency. Successful bidder should submit the Certificate and photographs of each system installed which must show complete installation setup with beneficiary, Pole number etc.

Successful bidder shall ensure that the project gets completed within the stipulated time frame. A

Project Monitoring Report shall be submitted to REIL / Agency during the execution of the project and Impact report to be submitted after completion of the constituency.

After installation/commissioning, the System will be handed over to State Nodal Agency and as the case may be and submit the handing over certificates to REIL / Agency within 15 days from the date of installation (in the prescribed format of REIL / Agency).

B. Operation & Maintenance (O&M):

Bidder has to submit an Operation, Instruction and Maintenance Manual, in English and the local language, should be provided with each Solar LED Street Lighting System to the beneficiary. The following minimum details must be provided in the Manual:

- Basic principles of Photovoltaic.
- A small write-up (with a block diagram) on Solar LED Street Lighting System its components, PV module, battery, electronics and luminaries and expected performance.
- A simple single line diagram (SLD) depicting the electrical circuits and control mechanism
- Type, Model number, Voltage & capacity of the battery, used in the system.
- The make, model number, country of origin.
- About Charging and Significance of indicators.
- Clear instructions about erection of pole and mounting of PV module (s) and lamp housing assembly on the pole.
- Clear instructions on regular maintenance and trouble-shooting of the Solar LED Street Lighting System.
- Preventive maintenance schedule
- Detail information about warranty coverage
- DO's and DONT's.
- Name and address of the contact person for repair and maintenance, in case of nonfunctionality of the solar LED street lighting system.
- Description of frequent faults of PV module, battery and panel and its remedy.
- Minimum 10 hard copies (to be printed in booklet form) kept at each service center. Also, to be provided to REIL / Agency as and when required.

The Operation & Maintenance (O&M) cost of the system is in-built in the system cost. The bidder shall provide AMC of the system for 5years.

It is mandatory for the bidder to open an authorized service center in each concerned District and sufficient spare parts i.e., driver, luminary, glass, battery etc. to be maintained at each service center The successful bidder should share the O&M report on monthly basis.

In case bidder fails to inform to REIL/ Agency about any change (contact detail/address) in the service center, REIL / Agency will take severe action against the bidder and bidder may not be able to participate any future tender of REIL / Agency.

Successful bidder shall depute sufficient service personnel at each service center to make routine maintenance. The maintenance shall include thorough testing & replacement of any damaged parts.

Any complaint registered/ service calls received / faults notified , the same should be attended within stipulated timeline and the system should be repaired/ restored/ replaced within 3 days from the date of complaint received/informed to the bidder.

C. INSURANCE:

INTEGRITY PACT

Between

Rajasthan Electronics & Instruments Limited (REIL), a company registered under the Companies Act 1956 and having its registered office at 2, Kanakpura Industrial Area, Jaipur-302012 (India) hereinafter referred to as "The Principal", which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning hereof shall include its successors or assigns of the ONE PART

In order to achieve these goals, the Principal will appoint Independent External Monitor(s), who will monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned above.

Section 1 - Commitments of the Principal

- 1.1 The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:-
 - 1.1.1. No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - 1.1.2. The Principal will, during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal will in particular, before and during the tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the tender process or the contract execution.
 - 1.1.3. The Principal will exclude from the process all known prejudiced persons.
- 1.2 If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a penal offence under the Indian Penal Code 1860 and Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 or anyther statutory penal enactment, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform its Vigilance Office and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

Section 2 - Commitments of the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s)

- 2.1 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.
- 2.1.1 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to the Principal or to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of the contract or to any third person any material, immaterial or any other benefit which he / she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or during the execution of the contract.

- 2.1.2 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.
- 2.1.3 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not commit any penal offence under the relevant IPC/ PC Act; further the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- 2.1.4 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the agent(s)/ representative(s) in India if any. Similarly the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principal(s) if any. Further details as mentioned in the "Guidelines on Indian Agent of Foreign Suppliers" shall be disclosed by the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s). Further as mentioned in the guidelines all the payments made to the Indian Agent/ Representative have to be in Indian Rupees only.
- 2.1.5 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- 2.2 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

Section 3 - Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts

If the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s), before award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 above, or acts in any other manner such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidders(s)/ Contractor(s) from the tender process or take action as per the separate "Guidelines for Suspension of Business Dealings with Suppliers/ Contractors" framed by the Principal.

Section 4 - Compensation for Damages

- 4.1 If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/ Bid Security.
- 4.2 If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages equivalent to 5% of the contract value or the amount equivalent to Security Deposit/Performance Bank Guarantee, whichever is higher.

Section 5 - Previous Transgression

- 5.1 The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 3 years with any other company in any country conforming to the anti-corruption approach or with any other Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.
- 5.2 If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or the contract, if already awarded, can be terminated for such reason.

Section 6 - Equal treatment of all Bidders/ Contractors/ Sub-contractors

- 6.1 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from his sub-contractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. This commitment shall be taken only from those sub-contractors whose contract value is more than 20% of Bidder's/ Contractor's contract value with the Principal.
- 6.2 The Principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.

6.3 The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this pact or violate its provisions.

Section 7 - Criminal Charges against violating Bidders/ Contractors Subcontractors

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the same to Vigilance Office.

Section 8 -Independent External Monitor(s)

8.1 The Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.

- 8.2 The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the MD, REIL.
- 8.3 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all contract documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s). The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will grant the monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his contract documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractor(s). The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) / Sub-contractor(s) with confidentiality.
- 8.4 The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the contract provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
- 8.5 As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- 8.6 The Monitor will submit a written report to the MD, REIL within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- 8.7 If the Monitor has reported to the MD, REIL, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC / PC Act, and the MD, REIL has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Vigilance Office, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India.
- 8.8 The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

Section 9 - Pact Duration

- 9.1 This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the respective contract and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded.
- 9.2 If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified as above, unless it is discharged/ determined by the MD, REIL.

Section 10 - Other Provisions

- 10.1 This agreement is subject to Indian Laws and jurisdiction shall be registered office of the Principal, i.e. Jaipur.
- 10.2 Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 10.3 If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 10.4 Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
- 10.5 Only those bidders/ contractors who have entered into this agreement with the Principal would be competent to participate in the bidding. In other words, entering into this agreement would be a preliminary qualification.
