Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition had been fled *inter alia* seeking directions to the Central Transmission Utility of India Limited to comply with the order dated 15.12.2022 passed by the Commission in Petition No. 206/MP/20219. Learned counsel submitted vide order dated 15.12.2022, the Commission held that PSPCL, along with other beneficiaries, were not liable to pay the transmission charges for the use of BBMB transmission assets for the 3rd and 4th quarters of FY 2016-17 and the transmission charges already paid by the beneficiaries (including PSPCL) for the said period were to be refunded back. However, even after accepting the order and the order having attained the finality, CTUIL has not complied with the directions of the Commission.

2. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission ordered as under:

(a) Admit and issue notice to the Respondents, subject to just exceptions;

(b) The Respondents to file their reply, if any, within six weeks with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, within six weeks thereafter.

3. The Petition will be listed for hearing on **29.4.2025**.
